The days are coming when I will make a new covenant with Israel and I will forgive their iniquity.

The parish RCIA group will head over to Kyabram on Sunday for a day of reflection lead by Kylie Smith.







Children will be called forward at a time during Mass to "lodge" their paperwork and receive a Welcome Pack.










This year marks 150 years since the foundation of the Sandhurst Diocese.
